Bailey, Sister Robert Joseph Elementary School received its 2016-2017 rating on the Nevada School Performance Framework. The NSPF evaluates multiple performance criteria and provides a more complete picture of student growth and achievement.

The NSPF classifies schools within a five star performance rating system. The NSPF includes multiple measures of student achievement and growth and aligns the designations for schools to the delivery of appropriate supports.

The following indicators are used to measure elementary and middle schools on the NSPF:



Academic Achievement is a measure of student performance on State assessments.



Growth is a measure of the increase of student performance on State assessments over time.



English Language Proficiency is a measure of an English Learners' growth towards English language proficiency on the State English language proficiency assessment.



Closing Opportunity Gaps is a measure of the improvement of the lowest performing students.



Student Engagement is a measure of chronic absenteeism and the percentage of students participating in a climate survey. For middle schools, student engagement also includes the percentage of students with a signed academic learning plan and the percentage of eighth grade students who are high school ready.
